We have First Communion for our young people who are in the third grade and there is an instruction period for them and their parents before they receive their First Communion.

The principal function of the committee is to promote the spiritual life of the church by working with the Pastor and other committees to plan worship for the church year.

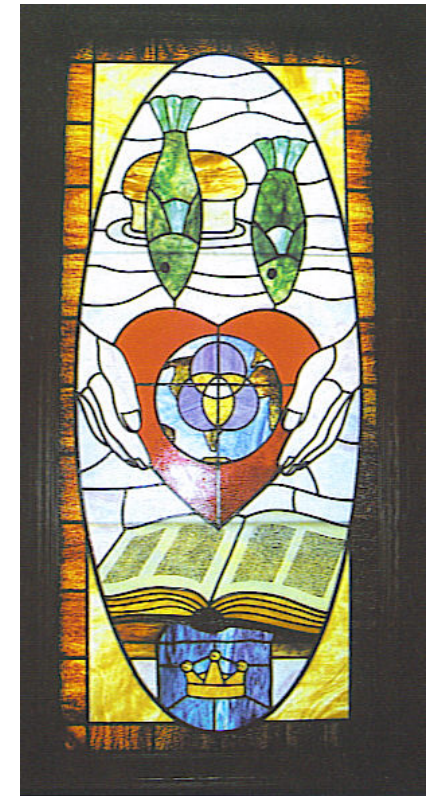
